COVID-19 Vaccination Campaign

Current Vaccination Phases:

- PHASE 1a - 80% of counties
 - PHASE 1b - 20% of counties

- As of December 12th, the Wyoming Department of Health and its partners have started distributing and administering COVID-19 vaccines as part of the continued response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - Initial shipments were sent to locations identified through early vaccine distribution planning efforts; vaccines are now being shipped to counties on a weekly basis

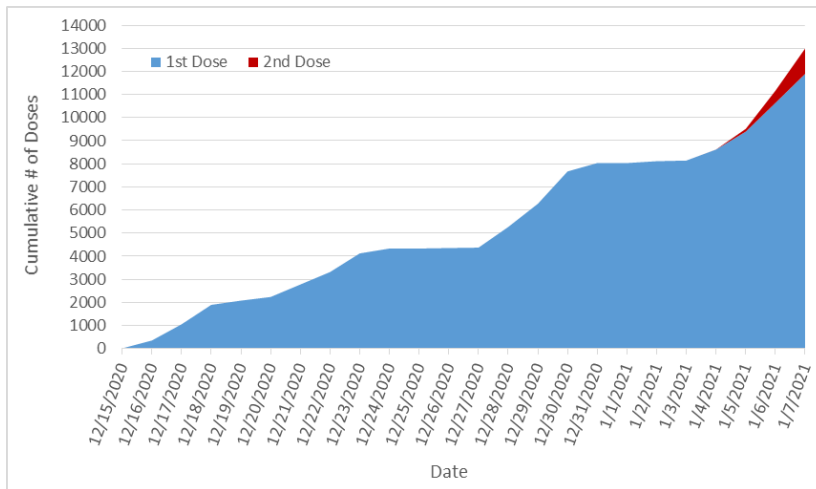

Key Points & Resources

- Vaccine supply is currently limited; county public health agencies will reach out to respective entities when sufficient vaccine is available and vaccination efforts can be expanded.
- Getting vaccinated is free; people receiving COVID-19 vaccines will not be asked to pay any fees.
- Over 60 Long-term Care Facilities (LTCF) and Assisted Living Facilities are receiving vaccine through the Federal Pharmacy Partners LTCF Program; Walgreens and CVS will provide COVID-19 vaccinations to residents and staff of these facilities in January. Second doses will also be provided through the program.
